The Rules

1. **Authors:** Type or write your essay, poem or short story in black ink on 8.5 x 11 inch white paper. Written submissions are limited to one page, single-spaced. Entries will not be returned.
2. **Artists:** Draw your work vertically in black ink on 8.5 x 11 inch white paper. No notebook paper, please. Black and white photographs are accepted. No copies or tracings. Artwork will not be returned.
3. Richland Library reserves the right to make editorial changes.
4. Each contributor may submit up to 10 entries. Each entry should be on a separate page with its own submission form.
5. Entries are due by **January 14, 2019**. See details below on submission options. Be sure to complete your entry information. **Incomplete entries will not be considered.**

Be sure to include all of the information requested for each entry (name, address, etc.) **Incomplete entries will not be considered.**

Written submissions may be included in the body of the e-mail or attached as a separate document.

- Links to Google Docs, Dropbox or other file sharing sites will not be accepted.
- Writers are strongly encouraged to submit their work online but if they are unable to do so, submissions will still be accepted in person.

Images should be scanned at the highest possible resolution.

- We reserve the right to disqualify incomplete entries and/or contributors who are unable to submit a high-resolution photograph of at least 300 dpi or an original photo negative or print.
- Photographs taken with smartphones are exempt from this requirement but must be submitted at their highest resolution.

Parents/Guardians: You are verifying that this submission is your child's original work and you are granting permission for your child's name, age, school and creative work to be used in Richland Library publicity materials. You will receive an automated reply confirming your first submission only.

Richland Library's literary magazine, *Kids in Print*, showcases the creative talents of young people, ages 6-18, across the Midlands. We accept poetry, stories, short plays, essays, drawings, photographs and more.

Kids in Print is not a competition. We are not able to publish everything so we include a variety of creative work that is original, well-crafted and contributes to the overall magazine. Congratulations on being brave and expressing yourself--whether you're published or not, you've succeeded!

- **Teachers:** Want to use *Kids in Print* as a class project? That's great, but please make sure the entries are on more than one topic. This helps us showcase a wide variety of creative work.
