The Pop Ups

The Pop Ups bring their silly live show full of puppets and cardboard robots to Richland Library!

Suggested Materials



- Cardboard Box
- Paints

Orchestra

In the song "Orchestra," The Pop Ups explore different sounds we can make with normal stuff that's in the room.

STEP 1

Look around for something that can make a sound. In the song, we shake keys, tap on the floor, and scratch on the fabric on our clothes.



STEP 2

Can you make a rhythm with some of the sounds you create? Can you sing a song over the rhythm?



STEP 3


Can you play a song with somebody else? Pick a song both of you know and accompany your voices with the rhythms of the objects in the room! Now you have your own band!

The ROBOT DANCE is led by a ROBOT that we made from a cardboard Box! Make your own Robot head with a cardboard box in your house!
