All zines in the ZINE COLLECTION have been donated by their creators. Inclusion does not guarantee an event or program. If selected, the first copy of your zine will remain in our archive for in-building use only. The second copy of your zine will be added to the ZINE COLLECTION at Richland Library and included in the library's catalog, making it available for checkout by any Richland Library cardholder at any location. Any circulating or noncirculating zine that becomes damaged by use will be removed from the ZINE COLLECTION.

To be considered for inclusion in the Zine Collection, submissions must meet the following criteria:

- Zines must be permanently bound with staples or another durable binding method.
- Priority will be given to zines created in South Carolina or by creators with ties to the state, particularly those connected to the Richland County area.
